

The adhesive tape must be selected to suit the substrate and the ambient conditions. Seek advice from trained personnel.

Ensure that the walls are stable, even, clean and dust-free. Remove any residue and unevenness.

How big is my area and how much do I need? Allow for 10 % offcut.

 $m^2 = 1_{Box}$ $m^2 = 3_{Boxes}$ $m^2 = 9_{Boxes}$ $m^2 = 12_{Boxes}$ For unlevel, cold external walls and where cable runs are required a rear-ventilated substructure is recommended.

Jump dimension: max. 65cm



Can be installed horizontally or vertically.



Not suitable for high temperature fluctuations and humidity! (e.g. wood-burning stoves, damp rooms or conservatories)
